Guidelines for Financial Aid Funding

- Any current student or prospective student may apply.
- The Financial Aid Committee meets monthly to review applications and make recommendations for the Haney Financial Aid Scholarship and the Haney Foundation Scholarship.
- Applications are available from any Guidance Counselor or the Financial Aid Counselor. The application must be received by the Financial Aid Counselor **three (3) working days prior** to the committee meetings listed below.

- ***All students, whether current or new, must meet TABE requirements or be enrolled in remediation to be eligible for this scholarship.***
- Students may apply for funding as frequently as needed throughout the school year; however, not all needs may be met due to limited availability of funds.
- The Financial Aid Counselor will notify students of their award within two weeks of the Financial Aid Committee meeting.
- Scholarships may be awarded for tuition, books, uniforms, or other school supplies. ***Funding is not available for cosmetology kits, transportation, childcare or household expenses.***
- Scholarships will be awarded for a maximum of one nine week period at a time. Only in-state tuition and fees will be awarded.
- Scholarship awards may **not** be used to reimburse tuition, books or other items that have already been purchased or paid.
- Students attending Continuing Workforce Education short courses are not eligible to receive funding for tuition or books.
- Attendance, grades, classroom behavior and disciplinary action may affect your eligibility for scholarships.
